

Forces Loans Cookie Usage

By using our website, you confirm that you are happy to accept our use of cookies.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed in your browser memory (Session Cookies) or on your computer's hard drive (Persistent Cookies) when you visit a website. They can't look into your computer or read any personal information or other material on your hard drive. Cookies can't carry viruses or install anything harmful on your computer.

Cookies help to make the interaction between users and websites faster and easier. They can remember information you supply as you move through an application process or login on a website. What cookies don't do is store any personal or confidential information about you.

Although you can block cookies, you may not be able to apply for a loan online if you have disabled cookies on your computer. We would therefore like you to keep cookies active on your computer during your visits to our website as parts of the site rely on them to work properly.

What cookies do we use?

We use a number of session cookies which only last for the duration of your visit to our website. When you close your browser these cookies are deleted. These session cookies do not collect or store any personal information, nor will any of the information stored identify you personally.

We do not use any persistent cookies. This type of cookie remains on your computer for 30 days after you have visited a site.

Turning cookies off

Your browser can be set to do any of the following:

- Reject all cookies
- Allow only 'trusted' site cookies
- Accept cookies only from websites you are currently using.
- Accept all cookies

We recommend that you don't block all cookies because parts of our website need them to work properly and for you to make an application on our website.
